## ARE YOU A ROTARY CENTURION?

The following information was sent to Esther by PDG Hugh Langridge to see if we can encourage more Rotarians to consider becoming a Centurion.

The "Centurion" program is run through the Australian Rotary Foundation Trust, it is designed to enable *individual* Rotarians and non Rotarians to support The Rotary Foundation by contributing a minimum of **AUD 100.00 each year for as long as they are in a position to do so** .

The contribution can be directed to the Annual Programs Fund or be Restricted Giving i.e. Polio Plus, the contribution is **Tax Deductible**.

" Centurion " members are issued with a membership certificate and a recognition pin, it is my preference that application forms [ copy attached ] and contributions come to me first, I then record the members details and print the membership certificate which I normally try to present myself, for the Goldfields we could try and organise a "mass" presentation.

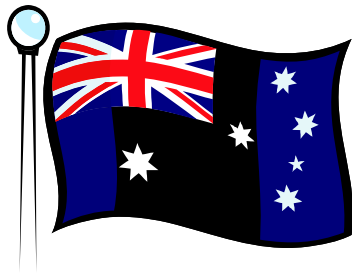
A copy of the application form and the contribution is then sent to PP Dom Manno [ District Foundation committee treasurer ], Dom then sends the contribution together with a TRFcontribution form to Parramatta.

The contribution is recorded against the individual Rotarian for the purpose of PHF credits, the PHF credits can be transferred to the Club if the individual wishes to do so, this needs to be done at a later date.

The contribution amount is credited to the Club and is included in the Club's annual giving contribution, it is included in the Districts DDF if it is directed to the Annual Programs Fund i.e. not restricted.

It is worth mentioning that there are several clubs in District 9470 where all of the members and a number of partners are "Centurions".

## **National Immunization Day in Nigeria.**

My fellow Rotarians, I am in the process of planning a NID in Nigeria and invite Rotarians whom wish to encounter a hands on experience of a life time, immunizing the children of Nigeria against Polio.

This is our promise to the children of the world, a world with out Polio.

I'm in touch with a PDG from District 9110 and the Rotarians from the Rotary Club of Vitoria Island East, whom will assist our team in planning and implementing the NID.

I have been assured that at all times there will be no safety issues, as our team will not be exposed to any volatile areas. Remembering that the Nigerians know of Rotary and of the great work we do eradicating Polio, and they all want the same as we do, to see their children are protected against the scourge of Polio.

Nigeria accounts for 79% of the global wild Poliovirus type 1 and 10% of the wild Poliovirus type 3 cases. Nigeria accounts for 90% of all Polio cases in Africa.

Polio is a **PAIN** to the children of the world and it is in **Pakistan, Afghanistan, India, Nigeria.**

The dates for the NID are 21<sup>st</sup> to the 24<sup>th</sup> of March 2009, the total time we will be away will be decided by the team. I would expect it to be 10 days in Nigeria.

Home stay could be possible but if not, they will negotiate good rates for us in suitable hotels. Internal transport will be provided by the Rotarians.

I have received cost's on flights with Emirates, from Perth / Dubai to Lagos and return at \$4,100 each person.

Glenys and I have lead several teams away, and have found that 20 Rotarians is a better number to travel with, therefore we are after 9 couples to travel with us.
